Gas cylinders are **prohibited** from being disposed of at Kimbriki. Please follow our listing of waste and gas facilities that are able to collect cylinders for safe disposal.

> LPG gas cylinders and fire extinguishers

WSN Environmental Solutions provide this service: **Only LPG, Halon** (yellow fire extinguishers), and **fire extinguishers** can be accepted. Two cylinders up to 9kg each per visit are accepted for free (June 2010).

The nearest WSN waste centre is at Crozier Road, off Forest Way, **Belrose**.

Asbestos, fibro products and insulation batts

All asbestos, fibro products and insulation batts must be wrapped or bagged in heavy duty plastic. Kimbriki will accept these products but only under the following conditions:

Asbestos products eg. fibro sheets, asbestos pipes or guttering etc.

1. Waste must be delivered bagged, or wrapped securely in heavy duty plastic, sealed so loose material cannot escape and will not puncture when being unloaded.
2. Bagged or wrapped waste **must be unloaded and placed by hand in the asbestos disposal area.**
3. Product will be charged at **\$370** per tonne, minimum charge **\$40**.
4. Limit 1 tonne

Glass fibre, rockwool, ceramic fibre insulation products eg. insulation batts

1. Waste must be delivered bagged, or wrapped in heavy duty plastic.
2. Bagged or wrapped waste **must be unloaded and placed by hand in the landfill area.**
3. Product will be charged at Mixed Waste rates.
4. Any product exposed even in transit will not be accepted!

> Asbestos

Kimbriki is licensed to receive materials that contain asbestos, provided that the material is a fibro type product, eg sheets, pipes or guttering and is delivered to the site wrapped in heavy duty plastic.

The customer must be able to satisfy us that the sheeting etc does not contain asbestos. If in any doubt we must presume it does.

The main problem is that there is no standard method of determining whether a “fibro” product contains asbestos.

Workcover take a similar approach – that is, if you cannot establish beyond reasonable doubt that the material does not contain asbestos – **PRESUME IT DOES.**

Any product that looks as if it contains asbestos will be treated as if it does. It will be required to be wrapped in parcels for disposal at Kimbriki.

Only products that are **stamped to identify that the product does not contain asbestos** will be accepted for unwrapped disposal.

If a customer is able to demonstrate that the product was recently purchased, then that material or offcuts may be delivered as Mixed Waste to the site.

> Loads will be checked

Kimbriki staff check loads for items that are contaminants, including asbestos. This keeps the site safe for customers and staff; and keeps it environmentally safe.

> Customers with unwrapped asbestos will be asked to leave!

If material that may contain asbestos is detected in the load, then the customer will not be permitted to deposit any waste and asked to leave the site.
